The Alberta Western Dressage 2024 Team Challenge is designed to encourage participation in Western Dressage across all of Alberta.

General Guidelines:

- Open to Alberta residents only.
- Current WDASA and/or WDANA membership required for all team members.
  - Required at time of Team Application.
  - Team Challenge entry is separate from annual membership.
- Scores can be from any online show, and/or any in person show in Alberta. (Or a combination of)
  - In person scores must be from a "show". Ride-a-test or judged practice sheets will not be accepted. Event must be classified as at least a "schooling show".
  - Scores can be from either/ or WDAA or WSDAC tests (or a combination of)
  - Gaited & Freestyle test scores accepted.
- Scored Test sheets must be available upon request to verify score(s). Publicly posted online scores can be used to verify score(s).
- Team Application form and payments due May 1<sup>st</sup> 2024.
- Team Applications will be accepted after May 1<sup>st</sup> but will be subject to a late fee. Scores obtained prior to Team Application will not be accepted.
- Each team will be allowed 1 substitution during the show season.
  - Substitution will be required to pay additional entry fee cost. Regardless if it is a rider change, horse change or a horse/rider combination change.
- Team Captain to submit Completed Team Score Sheet for their team by December 1<sup>st</sup>. Stating each horse/rider combination's top 3 scores received in 2024.

Team Requirements:

- Each team to be comprised of 3 or 4 horse/rider combinations.
  - If the team has 4 Horse/Rider combinations: The top 3 averages, based on the 3 individual horse/rider combination scores submitted will be used.
  - If the team has 3 Horse/Rider Combinations: All 3 averages, based on the 3 individual horse/rider combination scores submitted will be used.
- Horse/Rider combination only eligible for 1 Team.
- Rider may compete on another team with another horse. But not on the same team with another horse
- Horse may compete on another team with another rider. But not the same team with another rider.
  - Example:
    - Polly & Mr. Cracker Shoes on Team "Unstoppable Snacks"
    - Polly & Mrs. Potts on Team "Tea Divas"
    - Sandy & Mr. Cracker Shoes on Team "Western Winos"

- Teams can be comprised of any combination of Open, Adult Amateur & Juniors showing any level.
  - Example:
    - Rider 1 Open Showing Intro & Basic
    - Rider 2 Open Showing Level 3
    - Rider 3 AA Showing Intro
    - Rider 4 Jr Showing Basic
- A Team Captain is to be designated by the team and is responsible for submitting the team scores. The Team Captain will also be the main point of contact for their team.
- Depending on the team dynamics, each rider may choose to pay their own entry fee for the Team Challenge. Full payment for complete team entry will be required before Team Application is approved. Entry fee is \$15 per Horse/Rider Combination.
- Teams do not need to be from the same barn, area, club, group of friends etc. If a rider would like to participate in the Team Challenge but does not have a team, please reach out to WDASA. WDASA will create a list of these riders and will find/create teams for them. (Which is a fantastic way to "meet" fellow western dressage enthusiasts!)

Prizes:

- Prizes will be awarded to each member of each Team who submits an eligible score sheet.
  - The value of prizes will be directly based on the number of Team entries.
    - Buckles planned for the 2024 Champion team (Can be withdrawn by WDASA at any time due to financial status)
  - Additional prizes to be given out based on budget and additional sponsorships.
