

WDASA Ride-A-Test Guidelines

WDASA runs under the Western Dressage Association of America rules and tests.

Good working tack and western type apparel is all you need. Remember this not a show so have fun with it!

Helmets must be worn.

Filming Your Test:

- Film from "C", the judge's position
- Have person filming step back from C so the top of the rider to the bottom tip of the horse's feet are visible at all times
- If necessary, include some zoom when rider is at "A" end of the arena
- If filming on a smart phone, please film in the landscape orientation
- If filming outside of a standard arena please use poles to mark corners and sides of your ring. Be sure the arena markers are visible for the judge
- You may have someone call your test – be sure to keep the sound on when you submit your video whether you have a caller or not

-Tests are to be uploaded to Youtube. You may choose to set your video to unlisted so that only the person you send to can view, rather than public.
